



LECCINO – the leaf

Length (cm+ - E.S.): medium (5.72+ - 0.66)
 Width (cm+ - E.S.): medium (1.35+ - 0.12)
 Shape: oblong-lanceolate
 Surface of the lamina (square cm+ - E.S.): medium (5.67+ - 0.41)
 Curvature of the lamina longitudinal axis: flat
 Side view of the leaf lamina: flat
 Apical angle: open
 Basal angle: open
 Position of maximum width: central
 Colour of the upper surface: green

LECCINO – The fruit

Length (cm+ - E.S.): medium (2.01+ - 0.18)
 Maximum diameter: (cm+ - E.S.): narrow (1.32+ - 0.21)
 Shape: ellipsoidal
 Weight of 100 drupes (g+ - E.S.): medium (208.60+ - 37.02)
 Symmetry: slightly asymmetric
 Position of maximum diameter: central
 Apex shape: subconic, mucro almost always present.
 Base shape: flat
 Stalk cavity: circular, narrow, medium depth
 Exocarp: pruinose, smooth; not numerous small lenticels, similar to the olive colour in green olives and in the completely pigmented ones.
 Skin colour index: early, contemporaneous and slow
 Colour changes: green – purple red – black
 Pulp consistency: low
 Pulp consistency changes: fast decrease during the ripening process
 Pulp/stone ratio: medium-low
 Yield: medium
 Period of maximum inoliation: late
 Fall of unripe olives: low and late

LECCINO – Endocarp

Length (cm+ - E.S.): medium-short (1.51+ - 0.28)
 Maximum diameter (cm+ - E. S.): narrow (0.72+ - 0.15)
 Shape: ellipsoid-oblong
 Weight of 100 stones (g+ - E.S.): medium (39.89+ - 3.55)
 Symmetry: slightly asymmetric
 Position of maximum diameter: central, central-apical
 Surface: rugose
 Fibrovascular grooving: generally numerous grooves
 Course of fibrovascular grooving: longitudinal-irregular
 Depth of fibrovascular grooving: medium
 Base shape: pointed-tapered
 Apex shape: rounded
 Apex termination: medium rostrum

LECCINO - Inflorescence

Structure: thick
 Branching: scarce-medium
 Total length (cm+ - E.S.) medium (2.68+ - 0.26)
 Pedicel length (cm+ - E.S.): short (0.82+ - 0.12)
 Maximum width (cm+ - E.S.): narrow (1.12+ - 0.13)
 Number of flowers (n+ - E.S.): low (17.017+ - 1.88)
